2017 Quilt Show Challenge

"What Colour is your Rainbow?"

- The quilts must be no larger than 18 x 24 (if slightly larger due to binding, that is acceptable)
- \$10 Kits are available with a choice of either Black or White background (as long as supplies last)
- The colours in your quilt will be based on one of the colours of the rainbow (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple), no other colours are allowed.
 - You can use any shade, tint or tone of the colour you choose.
 - Defining Tint, Tone, and Shade:
 - Add white to a colour to create a tint.
 - If you add grey to a colour, you produce a tone.
 - Add black to a colour to make a shade.
- Tone on Tone fabrics can be used, however any fabrics with other colours are not allowed.
- Work to your strength and your imaginations - they can be pieced, appliquéd, painted, embroidered, embellished (buttons, charms, ribbon, lace, yarn, jewels), etc.
- Please be sure it has been properly put together with backing, batting and the top. It should be bound in some fashion. It must be entirely made and quilted by you.
- Your quilt must be ready to hang and include a pocket for the rod(s). We need to be able to just hammer a nail, or tie on some fishing line to screw-eyes. Please include the rod (label it with your name).
- Your name, the title of your work, category, and the date should be on a label stitched to the back.
- Categories are:
 - Novice (less than 4 years quilting experience)
 - Intermediate (4 to 10 years quilting experience)
 - Experienced (10 or more years quilting experience)
 - Winner's Circle (has won a previous challenge in the Experienced or Winner's Circle category).
- **New for this show:** Please submit your intent to submit a Challenge Quilt by the November 2016 meeting. This will allow us to be able to have tracking forms completed in advance of quilt submission.
- All entries are due at the January 2017 meeting. When handed in, you will be given a refund for your challenge kit. The entries will be displayed at the February 2017 meeting and voted on by members for Viewer's Choice. The winners will be announced at the quilt show, where all entries will be on display.
- Any entries that have 'questionable' fabrics will be reviewed by 3 members of the Quilt Show committee and a decision rendered on eligibility. Participants will be notified in advance of the February meeting if they have been disqualified.
- Ribbons will be awarded to the first and second entries in each of the categories.
